About the Museum

The Fan Museum is an accredited, independent museum dedicated entirely to the history, culture and craft of hand-held fans. The museum opened in 1991, in the heart of historic Royal Greenwich. Its collections of predominantly antique fans are housed within two Grade II* listed Georgian town houses. A compact permanent display showcases the museum's eclectic collection: from Early European fan paintings to contemporary designs. The first-floor gallery houses temporary exhibitions which encompass themes of fashion, art, politics, court life and more.

This post will assist and support the work of the Museum's Director and Curator, dealing with collection research & documentation practices, displays and exhibitions, loan administration, marketing & communications and specialist enquiries.
