# THE FAN MUSEUM

'A Hidden Treasure in the Heart of Historic Greenwich'



Located in historic Royal Greenwich, The Fan Museum occupies a pair of lovingly restored Listed Georgian townhouses. Open to the public since 1991, it is the only Museum in the UK celebrating the history of fans and the craft of fan making...

The collections exceed 7,000 objects (not all on show at the same time) and include fans from across the world dating from the 12th century to the present day.

The ground floor of the Museum houses a permanent display and serves as an introduction to fans: their history, manufacture, types and sources. A unique late-16th century flag fan forms part of the display, alongside fan designs painted by celebrated artists such as Paul Gauguin and Walter Sickert.

The first floor shows exhibitions which change three times each year, enabling the Museum to focus on different aspects of multilayered history and culture of the fan. Situating fans within their historical, social and cultural contexts, the dazzling displays are often combined with other works of decorative art such as ceramics, jewellery and costume.
